RESIDENT NOTICE

Water Services Interruption

Please note that the Town must conduct another essential repair to suspected broken water main on 20th Avenue (this time west of the firehall by the Town Administration building).

In order to repair the water main, it will be necessary to shut off the distributed water supply at the road valves located on 20th Avenue at some point later today.

The potable water supply to a number of properties will therefore be affected.

Please note that this work is scheduled to commence today Wednesday March 19, 2025.

We anticipate the period of interruption to be from 9:00am until later today, however these timings may change if unexpected issues arise. We will keep you informed of progress particularly if we envisage the period of interruption to be later than originally planned.

Please note that we will maintain water supply to your property for as long as possible however it will be necessary to turn off your water supply and as such you should take whatever necessary steps are required to provide a source of alternative water within your property for cooking, drinking and flushing purposes.

We will provide further notifications to you as necessary (eg: boil water advisory notification).

After the repair has been made and the water supply is resumed to your property, please run water through your faucets for a period of at least 10 minutes or until the water appears clear.

Water quality tests will be done immediately after the repair has been made to ensure that clean water supplies remain within the water distribution network.
