### Mayor Stuart's Community Message

We are starting the month of September with more seasonal weather and we are even getting some precipitation. School will be resuming on September 1<sup>st</sup> and Chinooks Edge School Division will be following Alberta Health Services protocols. Contact Chinooks Edge School Division or Bowden Grandview School for further information.

At our August 23<sup>rd</sup> Town Council meeting, a Public Hearing was held to provide the opportunity for feedback on proposed Bylaw No. 09/2021. After a presentation from Julie Hardes (Red Deer County Development Officer) the public was given the opportunity to make comments on the proposed bylaw. The Public Hearing was declared closed and Town Council gave second and third readings to bring the bylaw into effect. The motions for second and third readings were carried unanimously.

The federal election is on September 20, 2021 and the Pattison Bowden Community Hall has been booked from 7:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. for voting. September 20 is also the final day to file your Nomination papers for the municipal election. The Town of Bowden will be holding elections for six councilors and one Mayor and your Nomination Papers must be received at the Town Office before 12:00 p.m. (noon). Nomination Papers must be signed by at least five eligible electors and I would recommend that you have more than five in case one of the signees is declared ineligible. More information is available at the Town Office and nomination packages can be picked up there. Do not hesitate to contact myself or any of the Town Councilors for information or feedback.

As mentioned last month, you are required to have your sump pumps draining outside of your home and not into the sanitary sewer. The town is moving forward on a stormwater study and we will be looking at ways to minimize the amount of money we pay to the South Red Deer Regional Wastewater Commission. More information will be forthcoming.
