Mayor Stuart's Community Message

We start the month of March still under the first phase of the Alberta Covid Reopening Strategy. These rules are scheduled to be reviewed on March 1st. Hopefully, there will be enough progress to go into Phase Two, which will ease many of the requirements of Phase One.

Alberta has fallen behind in their proposed vaccination numbers. 375,000 Albertans were to have been vaccinated by February 28th. As of February 21st, 174,000 Albertans were vaccinated with 69,000 receiving two doses. As of February 24th, seniors who were born before 1947 can go online or to Health Link to book a Covid vaccine shot. Family members can book on behalf of those that are over seventy-five.

We are asking for help in identifying a man and a woman who broke into the Bowden Museum on the night of Monday, February 15th. The sad part of this is that the items they stole were only valuable in the historical sense. Some items stolen were: a World War II gas mask, a beret, war medals and service badges that were donated by family members. They also broke glass display cases to steal Avon collectibles. I hope that many of you have had the opportunity to look at the Town of Bowden's new website. Council is very pleased with the initial look and the feedback that we have received. I would like to thank Town of Bowden staff and the Economic Development Committee for their work. The Economic Development Committee is working to promote all aspects of Bowden and are looking for a volunteer to sit on the committee. The Town of Bowden would like to announce that there will soon be an app available which will greatly assist in making current information more accessible to residents and visitors. We hope to do a public launch in the near future.

At our February 22nd meeting, Town Council passed a \$450,000 Capital Budget. Half of this budget is for the resurfacing and improvements to 22nd street. This is the entrance road that comes in from Secondary Highway #587 past the school. The other half will go to equipment, structures and street light upgrades.

At this meeting we also gave the first two readings to our Municipal Election Bylaw. Our municipal election is on October 18th and this bylaw will supplement the rules and regulations of the provincial Local Authorities Election Act. Information and nomination papers are available at the Town Office.

Just a reminder that Daylight Savings Time will come into effect at 2:00 a.m. on Sunday March 14th.
