Voting will take place between the hours of 10:00 am and 8:00 pm at the voting station located at the Paterson Community Centre, 2101 – 27 Ave, Bowden.

Proof of elector eligibility.

Pursuant to: Local Authorities Election Act, Section 53(1) and the Town of Bowden Municipal Election Bylaw 02 / 2021 sections 10.3 and 10.4).

i.produce for inspection at least one form of acceptable identification (with full civic address) proving residency within the Town of Bowden, or ii. have someone (who satisfies (i) above) vouch for your eligibility and attends with you in person, or

iii. have someone make a statement vouching for your eligibility.
