COVID-19 (Corona Virus) – Update

Further to all previous communications please note that the Town has again reviewed operational practices following the announcement of provincewide mandatory restrictions recently declared by the Provincial Government.

The most significant new safeguards are:

- i. the mandatory wearing of face masks in all indoor public places, places of worship and indoor workplaces,
- ii. a ban on all indoor and outdoor social gatherings, both public and private.

These mandatory restrictions will remain in place until at least January 12, 2021.

With regard to Town services please note the Town Administration Office will remain open, Monday to Friday 8.00am until 4.00pm each day. However, masks are mandatory and only one visitor is allowed in the building at any point in time. In addition, due to the introduction of reduced staffing levels the timely delivery of some services may be restricted so please bear this in mind.

Public Works will continue to ensure that essential services continue to operate normally, for example, water distribution, wastewater operations and snow removal.

The Town Library will be closed to all visitors as from Saturday 12th December. A limited curbside pick service will be available every Wednesday. Please refer to the notices posted on the Library front door for further details.

The situation is being continually assessed and restrictions may be scaled either up or down depending on the evolving situation, perceived levels of risk and of course any additional mandatory requirements.

I strongly urge all residents to follow the guidelines in place and ask that together as a community we remain diligent, maintain our focus on COVID-19 prevention and ensure our community remains a safe and healthy place.
