COVID-19 (Corona Virus) - Update

In response to the Government of Alberta's declaration of a State of Public Health Emergency the Town has again reviewed operational practices. Please note that with immediate effect:

- i. the wearing of face masks is required for all visitors to the Town Municipal Office,
- ii. only one visitor is allowed in the office at any one time.

These mandatory restrictions will remain in place until further notice.

With regard to Town services please note the Town Administration Office remains open as normal, Monday to Friday 8:00am until 4.00pm each day. However, due to the introduction of reduced staffing levels the timely delivery of some services may be restricted so please bear this in mind.

Public Works will continue to ensure that essential services continue to operate normally, for example, water distribution and wastewater operations.

The Town Library is open, subject to the following restrictions: the wearing of face masks is required for all visitors and there is a maximum occupancy capacity of 12 persons. A curbside pickup service is available every day by prior arrangement – Tel: 403-224-3688.

The situation is being continually assessed and restrictions may be scaled either up or down depending on the evolving situation, perceived levels of risk and of course any additional mandatory requirements.
